

Band Director Mr. Spencer Oyster




- Graduate of Florida State University with a major in Instrumental Music Education






Board Purpose

Marching Band




- Consists of:
 - Brass
 - Woodwinds
 - Percussion
 - Color Guard



- Competes in Division 3A, but can changes based on the number of participants
 - Over 100 participants would move us to Division 4A
 - Participates in circuits such as Florida Marching Band Championships, Bands of America, and many others!
- Plays at home and away football games to support the school and football team
- Plays at community and school outreach events!
- Performs at annual Marching Band Music Performance Assessment (MPA)



Class Ensembles




- Concert Band
 - Develops basic technical skills on wind and percussion instruments in concert ensemble literature
- Symphonic Band
 - Develops intermediate-level technical skills on wind and percussion instruments in standard concert ensemble literature
- Wind Ensemble
 - Develops advanced technical skills on wind or percussion instruments in advanced concert ensemble literature
- Jazz Band
 - Develops basic-intermediate skills in performance of jazz ensemble literature
- Jazz Ensemble
 - Develops advanced level skills in performance of standard jazz ensemble literature
- Also, performs at Music Performance Assessments (MPAs) and Solo and Ensemble Events

• Visual interpretation of music and integral to marching band performance

• Members spin flags, rifles, and sabers

can also be used
















Football Games

- Plays stand tunes during the game and performs their show at halftime






Daytona 500



Fundraising Committee




- We are looking for volunteers to join a Fundraising Committee to plan and execute fundraisers.








Dues

- Competition Entry Fees
- Staff Payments
- Transportation Costs
- Busses for Students, Equipment Trucks for instruments/props/etc.
- Instrument Maintenance
- Administration Costs (Quickbooks, CPA, Cognito Forms, Website, etc.)

• Create spreadsheet of expected expenses and expected fundraising revenue


Expected Expenses — Expected Fundraising Revenue — Amount Needed

- Do you notice the bolded words? The budget is based on estimations, as we do not know exact amounts in many cases.
- The amount of fundraising and parent volunteer participation <u>**DOES**</u> affect dues.



Volunteering/Fundraising Impact



- Fundraising revenue comes from:
 - Events planned by the Fundraising Committee
 - Sponsorships
 - Parking Spot Auction
 - Concessions Stand
 - We sold almost \$11,000 worth of concession food!
 - Two Mulch Fundraisers
 - We sold over 5,500 bags of mulch!
- Profits for 2022 came to just under \$25,000, which equals about \$300 per student (based on 2022 student numbers)
 - The fundraising amount and volunteer support affects our financial position.


