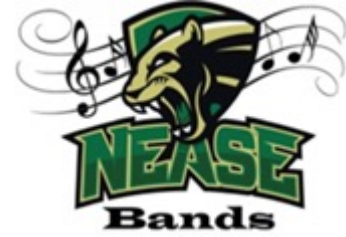

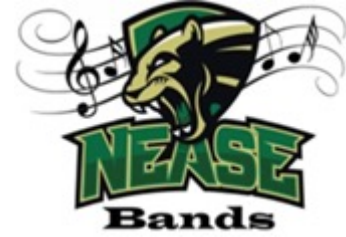


- Florida-native: Tallahassee home-grown

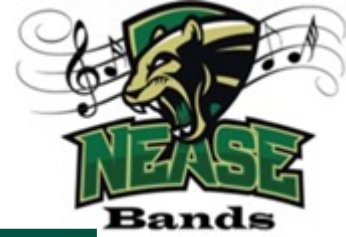
Football Games

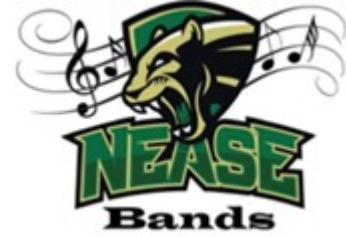

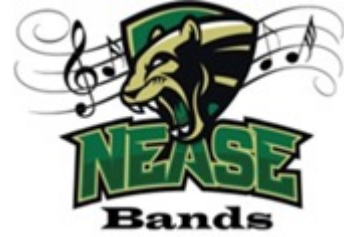
Atlanta Trip (Buford, GA)

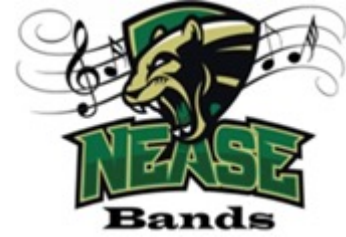


- About \$50 a person

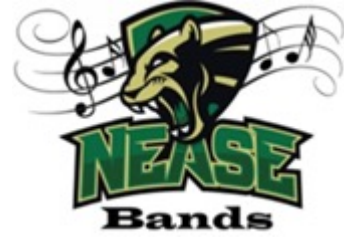

- Dri-fit shirts, show shirts, and water bottles are considered part of their uniform.



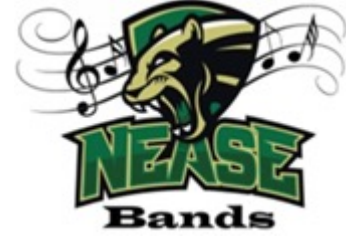

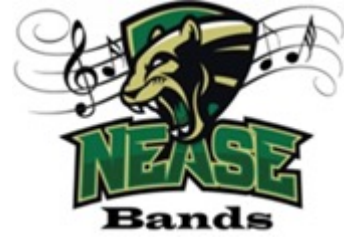


- Mulch Drive

Duck Race

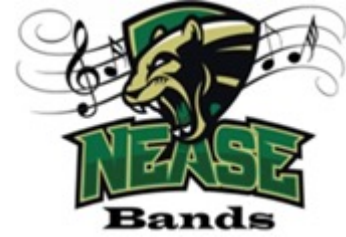


- Buy a duck for \$10 and watch the live stream on Instagram as the ducks race through Nocatee's lazy river!

Super Bowl Squares



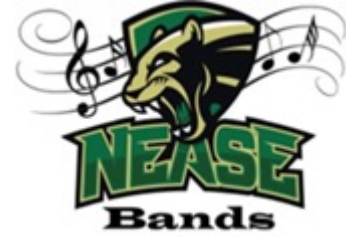
- \$20 a square

Volunteering/Fundraising Impact



- Fundraising revenue comes from:
 - Events planned by the Fundraising Committee
 - Sponsorships
 - Parking Spot Auction
 - Concessions Stand
 - Two Mulch Fundraisers
- Profits for 2022 came to just under \$25,000, which equals about \$300 per student (based on 2022 student numbers)
 - The fundraising amount and volunteer support affects our financial position.

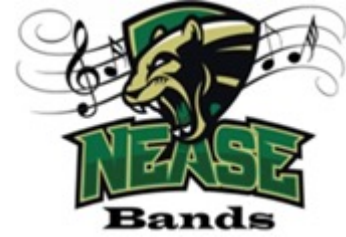


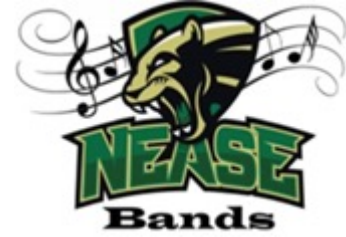
