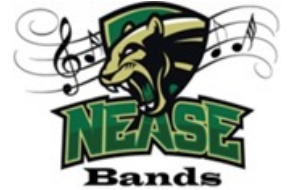
Atlanta Trip (Buford, GA)

- Dinner – Medieval Times Dinner Show

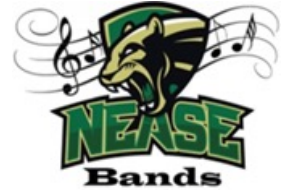
Saturday

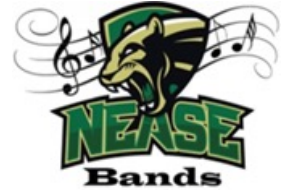

Super Bowl Squares

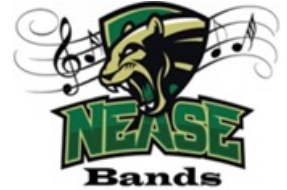


- \$20 a square
