Summer Band Camp

- Last week of Band camp will end the week before school starts.
- Percussion 1st and 2nd years will attend the first week of band camp.

2024-2025 Budget

- Estimated \$168,867 Budget cost for the 2024/2025 season.

- We will be hosting S&E again this year but budgeting the price this year.
- The budget was passed with a majority vote.

By-Law Updates

2024-2025 Budget

The Band Booster Board presented the new budget. Mr. Oyster went over line by line, show old and new costs. He answered any question throughout the presentation. The general board approved the budget.

You can download the budget and review where our expenses are for the upcoming band and color guard year.

Dues cost

Marching Band and Color Guard Dues: \$1,350 per student

The 2024-2025 dues cover the following:

- Uniforms, except for dinkles (shoes)
- New Show shirts
- Food, drinks, and snacks before football games/competitions
- Transportation to and from away games and competitions
- Team building events such as trivia, ice cream social, etc.
- Overnight transportation, lodging, food for State Competition
- Fun dinner/event for overnight State Competition
- Daytona 500 tickets and transportation for students
- Music and choreography of show
- Staff salaries
- Equipment maintenance
- MPA transportation
- Rental Truck for equipment to competitions
- AND MORE!

Band Ensemble dues: \$125 per student.

- Covers transportation to and from MPAs, music, clinics, etc.
- Additional \$50 for new students who need uniforms.
- Additional \$ for multiple classes

Due to additional staff and the change of location for BOA we went over budget this year. The goal is to be in the black this year and then we can lower the dues down as a whole and still offer the incentives too.

New Fundraising Opportunities to Help Pay Dues

The Band Booster Board has developed 3 ways to help pay for student band and color guard dues. There are volunteer and fundraising opportunities that all families can participate in. It is up to each family as to how much they earn towards their dues. Our Goal is that we can be in

the black this year, then we can lower the dues as a whole, and still offer the fundraising options to help offset the costs.

Dues Incentives – \$250

Parents have the opportunity to receive \$250 towards the student band account that will help pay for dues. Parents will need to volunteer their time at 5 events and meet the following criteria:

- You MUST volunteer at ONE of the mulch drives. We hold a Fall Mulch Drive in Sept/Oct., and a Spring Mulch Drive in Mulch. You will help drive students around delivering mulch starting at 8am and usually ending around 12/1pm.
- You MUST volunteer at the band concession stand at one of our home football games. Our Concession Stand offers a variety of food to patrons, and we need parents to cook food, sell food, be a runner, help refill the drinks and clean up at the end of the night. We start at 5:30pm and run to the end of the football game.
- You MUST volunteer to help with props at a football game/competition. Without these volunteers our show cannot happen. We need parents to help load and unload trucks at competitions, as well as move the equipment on/off the field at competitions and football games.
- You MUST volunteer at 2 additional volunteer opportunities such as are chaperoning, feeding the students, concessions, props, mulch. The choice is yours.
 - Board members and managers will automatically get the dues incentive of \$250 due to all the volunteer time they perform with their positions.

Band Bucks – Referral Program

Certain fundraisers such as football squares, duck race sales, corporate sponsors and raffles will earn you 10% of YOUR personal referral sales as BAND BUCKS.

- You MUST have the students name on any of the forms/sales for your family to receive the 10% credit.
- If a student name is NOT included on the form, there will be no commission awarded and the band fund will receive all monies.
- Band Bucks are good for a marching band and color guard calendar year.
- Band Bucks can be used towards unpaid band dues, merchandise, band banquet, etc.
- NO REFUNDS will be given. Any unused band bucks will be donated to the bands general fund.

General Band Fund

Certain fundraising events such as Spirit nights, merchandise sales, zumbathon, etc. will go directly to the band.

Underclassman Assistant to the Band Manager for New Band Season

A few of our managers have been volunteers for the past 2/3 years. Their students may be seniors next year and/or will transition out of their role in a year. We need a few underclassman volunteers to work alongside these managers to learn the ropes and support them throughout the year. The underclassman assistants will step into the manager role for the 2025/2026 band season.

• Uniform Underclassman Assistants

Melissa and Trish Johnson have graciously volunteered their time for the past few years as our Uniform Managers. They will be holding the same position this year, but are looking for 2 people to help out as they will transition out of this roll in April of 2025 preparing for their son to graduate. Our Uniform volunteers manage all the pieces of the marching band uniform. Some of the things they do are measure each student in the summer and coordinate the sizing for the band uniform. They help the students get their plumes before games and gather them after games. They fix broken shakos and replace lost gloves. They gather all cleaned uniforms at the end of the year and take inventory.

• Equipment Underclassman Assistants

David Yake has dedicated many hours to the band as our equipment and field guru volunteer. Some of the things David manages, with other parent volunteers, is the equipment and props – getting to the football field before games, on and off the field for halftime quickly, and back to storage after the game. David also is our tetris genius who can load the equipment into the truck securely for away games and competition. He also paints the yard lines on our practice field a few times in the summer, so the students can learn their correct positions. David would love to have someone learn what he does so that they are prepared to take over next April, and to give him the opportunity to see his son play during halftime from the stands instead of behind a prop or off to side.

• Volunteer Coordinator

Carol Diachun has dedicated many hours to the band as our Volunteer Coordinator and has graciously volunteered for another year. However, her son will be a Senior next year so we need to have an underclassman assistant help her this years. She will go over the systems she has in place to keep track of student volunteer hours, how she preps the student volunteer letters, how she set-ups the sign-up genius. Carol took on tracking the parent volunteer hours this year for the dues incentive and will continue to do that this year. The underclassman assistant will help monitor parent volunteers and work with the board to make sure everyone is receiving their volunteer credits.
