#### Nease Fall Mulch Drive - 2024

The mulch drive is our second largest fundraiser. We hold the fundraiser twice a year, in the Spring and Fall. Each family, including parent and student, is asked to complete ONE mulch drive during the season to qualify for the volunteer incentive. The spring mulch drive has already occurred, so if you did not volunteer you will need to volunteer for the Fall Mulch drive to qualify for the incentive.

We need larger vehicles (*Trucks and SUV*) or trailers to load and carry mulch, PLUS passenger cars (*small SUV or minivans*) to carry students. Note that students cannot drive for school-related function, so we need our parents to make this a quick and successful mulch drive. We will reward everyone with coffee, coco, water and pasties for breakfast. Then we will have the famous band chili for lunch.

Students who volunteer will receive service hours. Parents will receive 1 credit towards their volunteer incentive.

#### \$250 Dues Volunteer Incentive Requirements

Parents have the opportunity to receive \$250 towards the student band account that will help pay for dues.

Parents will need to volunteer their time at 5 events and meet the following criteria:

- You MUST volunteer at ONE of the mulch drives. We hold a Fall Mulch Drive in Sept/Oct., and a Spring Mulch Drive in March. We need parents to help drive students around delivering mulch starting at 8am and usually ending around 12/1pm.
- You MUST volunteer at the band concession stand at one home football game. Our Concession Stand offers a variety of food for sale, and we need parents to prepare food, sell food, be a runner, help refill the drinks and clean up at the end of the night. We start at 5:30pm and run to the end of the football game. We always need volunteers so please consider helping at more than one game.
- You MUST volunteer to help with props and equipment at a football game/competition or loading and unloading the equipment truck at away events. Without these volunteers our show cannot happen. We need parents to help load and unload trucks at competitions, as well as move the equipment on/off the field at competitions and football games.
- You MUST volunteer at 2 additional volunteer opportunities such as chaperoning, feeding the students, concessions, props, mulch. The choice is yours.
