












Universal Studios




- Still in planning stages

- More details will be provided after the Marching Season









 - Dinkles (shoes)


Color Guard Costumes

Uniform Care

 - Use only non-chlorine household laundry detergent.
 - NOTE: Always test wash one garment before the entire set.
- PDF with full care instructions was posted on the band app










- Mulch Drive

Battle of the Bands: Ducks vs Sharks




- Buy a duck for \$10 and watch the live stream on Instagram as the ducks race through Nocatee's lazy river!



 - Must purchase by Sunday, August 12th







Payment Options




- Paypal add a 3% fee that PayPal charges us
 - neaseaccts@gmail.com
- Vemno –No fee if you pay directly from your phone!
 - @neasebandboosters
 - Last four digits of the phone number: 4552
 - If you choose Vemno from the Online Forms, it is processed through PayPal (who owns Vemno) so the fee still gets charged
- Cash/Check (Brown box in band room)
- If you drop mid-season, you will charged for the months you participated

You MUST put your student's name and what the payment to guarantee it gets applied to your student's account.



Scholarships



- Scholarships amounts can vary but will not exceed 33% of the current year's dues, excluding the volunteer incentive.
- Save your spot fee of \$100 must be paid for the application to be considered


